

Health and Medical Response to Flood Situation

Dated 03-06-2025

Department of Health Services: Activities taken up by the Health teams at various identified flood related relief camps.

District Administrations have identified the relief camps of Imphal East, Imphal West and Senapati districts.


The Health department has deployed 16 Health Rapid Response Team (RRT) for Imphal East, Imphal West and Senapati districts.

The team has visited the following identified flood relief camps and examined the inmates. Medicines and other medicinal items like ORS, antibiotic ointments and first aid items, etc. were also distributed. Apart from it, awareness to the inmates was given regarding water borne diseases like diarrhoea, typhoid, hepatitis A, etc. The importance of hand washing before eating and after coming out from toilets were also highlighted.
