

Project: Providing free public Wi-Fi connectivity

STATUS: COMPLETED

Digital India is a campaign launched by the Government of India to ensure that Government services and information are made available to citizens electronically in the online mode. To leverage this Electronic Online platform, Internet connectivity is a critical medium and it is important that citizens have access to Internet access.

To improve Internet availability for the public, DIT, Government of Manipur proposes to provide free public Wi-Fi connectivity at 5 (five) important public places at Imphal as a pilot project.

2. All Mobile Service Providers were invited to take part in this project. However, only BSNL has shown interest in the project and as BSNL is a Government of India PSU, BSNL Manipur has been entrusted with setting up the necessary equipment and providing the required bandwidth. Details of the proposed locations along with the respective number of Access Points and Backhaul Bandwidth is as under:
